She has taught at numerous universities in Greece and abroad and has held managerial positions in the public and private sectors. Until June 2024, she was a Full Professor at the Agricultural University of Athens (Department of Regional and Economic Development). Since then, she has been appointed as an Associate Professor at the Hellenic Mediterranean University, specializing in Applied Economics in the Environment and Sustainable Development.

She has authored over 90 articles in peer-reviewed international journals with an impact factor and has written or edited 10 books in both Greek and English. Her scholarly work has received over 2,800 citations with an H-index of 27 (according to the Scopus database) and approximately 4,700 citations according to Google Scholar with an H-index of 33. Her research interests focus on Energy, Environment, Tourism, and Sustainable Development.

At the Agricultural University of Athens, she served as Vice Chair of the Department of Regional and Economic Development and Director of its Doctoral Program.
